

## NOTICE OF ACTION

Notice is given under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.080, that the Washington State Department of Transportation took the action described in (2) below on April 29, 2008.

1. Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of noncompliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (SEPA) shall be commenced on or before May 27, 2008.
2. **Description of agency action:** Design approval of the project entitled, S. Massachusetts St. to Railroad Way S. Electrical Line Relocation, by the Washington State Department of Transportation.
3. **Description of proposal:** The Washington State Department of Transportation proposes to relocate electrical utility network distribution and transmission lines currently suspended from the Alaskan Way Viaduct between the Massachusetts Substation and the Railroad Way South ramps into an alignment parallel to and east of the Alaskan Way Viaduct. The relocation involves two types of electrical lines: five network feeder distribution lines and two transmission lines. Construction of the two new alignments (distribution and transmission) will consist of new underground ductbanks and vaults, four new distribution vaults, and two new transmission vaults.
4. **Location of proposal:** The work will occur along a roughly 2-mile-long corridor near the Seattle waterfront from roughly the intersection of S. Massachusetts St. and Colorado Ave. S., north to the intersection of Railroad Way S. and the Alaskan Way Viaduct.
5. **Type of environmental review under SEPA:** A SEPA Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) was issued on February 1, 2008, after review of an Environmental Checklist. A SEPA Addendum was issued on April 18, 2008; WSDOT determined that the impacts identified in that addendum did not change the findings of the DNS.
