# InRoads – Horizontal Annotation Preferences

## **Overview**

CAE has created a set of InRoads preferences used to annotate the horizontal alignment, stationing and curve information for the various alignments used in PSE plans, RW plans and working drawings. The three commands - View Horizontal Annotation, View Stationing and View Curve Set Annotation - are used to annotate InRoads horizontal alignments; each command has a set of identical preferences used to control the annotation. All preferences except WSDOT will force the alignments to display in the style selected regardless of the alignment's assigned style.

The **WSDOT** preference can be used to display any horizontal alignment with its assigned style if **Point Element** is enabled - the point will be drawn using the Cogo point style and not the **AL\_HW\_CLinePSECurvePtCircle** style.

## Basic Workflow

Open an InRoads geometry file with a horizontal alignment(s). Use the View Horizontal Annotation, View Stationing and View Curve Set Annotation commands to annotate alignment using appropriate preference.

### **Preference Details**


**WSDOT** – use to annotate any non-stationed alignment with its assigned style.

- **\_Cline PSE** use to annotate PSE Existing centerline alignment in a PSE Base file.
- **\_Cline PSE New** use to annotate PSE New centerline alignment in a PSE Base file.
- **\_Cline PSE RW** use to annotate PSE Exist Right of Way centerline alignment in a PSE Base file.
- \_Cline PSE Wall New use to annotate PSE Wall New centerline alignment in a PSE Base file.
- **\_Cline RW Cntrl** use to annotate Right of Way centerline alignment in a RW Base file.
- **\_Workline** \* use to annotate any work line or centerline with color of preference name not to be used in PSE RW plans unless approved by plans review.

**Default** – use to annotate any alignment on default level not to be used in PSE or RW plans.

# **Open Geometry file:**

- 1. Select the File > Open command.
- 2. Set Files of type: to Geometry Projects (\*.alg).
- 3. Navigate and select the geometry project file and click **Open**.
- 4. Close the Open dialog.



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## **Project Options Preference**

Before the alignment is annotated an InRoads Project Options preference may needs to be loaded.

- 1. Select the *File > Project Options* command.
- 2. Select Preferences.
- 3. Select and load the appropriate preference:

Use **\_PSE** Base when annotating alignments in a PSE Base DGN file; annotate horizontal alignments with styles of **AL\_HW\_CLinePSE**, **AL\_HW\_CLinePSENew** and **AL\_RW\_CLineRWforPSE**.

Use **\_RW** Base when annotating alignments in a RW Base DGN file; annotate horizontal alignments with styles of **AL\_RW\_CLineRWCntrl**.

Use WSDOT when annotating any alignments in a working DGN file.

Note: the default scale for **\_PSE Base** is set to 100 and **\_RW Base** is set to 200. If you are working in at a different scale, the scale needs to be adjusted under the *Factor* tab.

#### **View Horizontal Annotation Command**

The View Horizontal Annotation command draws the path of the alignment, the cardinal points (POB, PC, PT, and POE) and the bearing direction of each tangent.

- 1. Select the Geometry > View Geometry > Horizontal Annotation command.
- Select Preferences.
- 3. Select and load the appropriate preference for the style of alignment see <u>Preference Details</u> on previous page.
- 4. In the *Horizontal Alignments* area, select the alignment(s) to be annotated.
- 5. Click Apply.

## **View Stationing Command**

The View Stationing command draws the station ticks and the major and submajor stations text along with the cardinal, PI and station equation stations leader and station text.

- 1. Select the *Geometry > View Geometry > Stationing* command.
- 2. Select Preferences.
- 3. Select and load the appropriate preference for the style of alignment see <u>Preference Details</u> on previous page.
- 4. In the *Horizontal Alignments:* drop list, select the alignment to be annotated.
- Click Apply.


# Modifying the direction of the Stations Ticks, Text direction and Leader

Due to alignment directions and plan sheet orientation there may be times the alignment tick marks, leaders and the station may be drawn in the wrong direction. The below sections will show you how to change the major and sub major station tick, and their text.

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## **Modifying Tick Direction**

Defining the direction of the Submajor and Minor Stations is controlled by the Regular Stations settings.



- 1. Select the *Geometry > View Geometry > Stationing* command.
- 2. Verify the correct preference is loaded.
- 3. Select Regular Station leaf.
- 4. In the *Ticks* area set the *Left Offset: Submajor* and *Minor* values to 0.000.
- 5. In the *Ticks* area set the *Right Offset: Submajor* value to 0.05 and the *Minor* values to 0.025.
- Click Apply.

Verify the tick marks were drawn on the correct side of the alignment.

7. Select **Preferences** and save a new preference to store the modified settings.

# **Modifying Text Direction**


The text direction is initially controlled by the style symbology. The symbology will need to be edited to change the direction of the text. Click to open the Text Symbology dialog associated with appropriate stations text i.e. Major, Submajor, Cardinal, PIs and Station Equations Stations.

- 1. Select the Geometry > View Geometry > Stationing command.
- 2. Verify the correct preference is loaded.

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
3. Select Regular Station leaf.

4. In the Data: area right of the Name column for Major Station Click the icon.



The <u>Text Symbology</u> dialog with the **AL\_HW\_CLinePSEMajorStaText** symbology loaded.

5. In the Rotation area change Angle: to -90




- 6. Click **OK** to close the <u>Text Symbology</u> dialog.
- 7. Click **Apply** the station text should redraw to the other side of the line.
- 8. Select **Preferences** and save a new preference to store the modified settings.

Note: this process can be used on any text symbology. You may also need to change the text justification on station leader text in order to get the text to align correctly on the leader.

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### **Modifying Leader Direction**

The leaders setting for the various station texts in the View Stationing dialog are similar. This technote will use the cardinal stations leader to demonstrate modifying leader direction. Leader Line Segment 1 determines the distance and direction of the first section of the leader and the Leader Line Segment 2 determines the distance and direction from the first leader.



- 1. Select the Geometry > View Geometry > Stationing command.
- 2. Select Cardinal Station leaf.
- 3. In the Leaders: area change Segment 1 Angle value to a -90
- 4. Click **Apply** verify the leader segment 1 is being drawn in the correct direction.
- 5. Repeat step 3 and 4 If Segment 2 is dawn in the wrong direction.
- 6. Select Preferences and save a new preference to store the modified settings.

### **View Curve Set Annotation**

- 1. Select the Geometry > View Geometry > Curve Set Annotation command.
- 2. Select Preferences.
- 3. Select and load the appropriate preference.
- 4. In the Horizontal Alignments: drop list, select the alignment to be annotated.
- 5. Click Apply.
