2 **Contractor Surveying – ADA Features**

3 **ADA Feature Staking Requirements**

4 The Contractor shall be responsible for setting, maintaining, and resetting all
5 alignment stakes, and grades necessary for the construction of the ADA features.
6 Calculations, surveying, and measuring required for setting and maintaining the
7 necessary lines and grades shall be the Contractor's responsibility. The Contractor
8 shall build the ADA features within the specifications in the Standard Plans and
9 contract documents.

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11 **ADA Feature Contract Compliance**

12 The Contractor shall be responsible for completing measurements to verify all ADA
13 features comply with the Contract in the presence of the Engineer.

14
15 **ADA Feature As-Built Measurements**

16 The Contractor shall be responsible for providing the latitude and longitude of each
17 ADA feature as indicated on the ADA Inspection Form(s) (WSDOT Form 224-020).

18
19 The completed ADA Inspection Form(s) (WSDOT Form 224-020) shall be
20 submitted as a Type 3 Working Drawing and transmitted to the Engineer within 30
21 calendar days of completing the ADA feature. After acceptance, the Contracting
22 Agency will submit the final form(s) to the WSDOT ADA Steward.

25 **Payment**

26 Payment will be made for the following bid item that is included in the Proposal:

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28 "ADA Features Surveying", lump sum.

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30 The lump sum Contract price for "ADA Features Surveying" shall be full pay for all the
31 Work as specified.

33 In the instance where an ADA feature does not meet accessibility requirements, all work
34 to replace non-compliant work and then to measure, record the as-built measurements,
35 and transmit the electronic forms to the Engineer shall be completed at no additional
36 cost to the Contracting Agency.
