5	payment, for qualifying changes in the index price of on-highway diesel fuel. The		
6	adjustment will be applied to partial payments made according to Section 1-09.9.

8	The adjustment is not a guarantee of full compensation for fuel price changes. Any		
9	adjustment provided by this provision shall not obligate the Contracting Agency for		
10	any costs due solely to changes in fuel costs beyond the amount adjusted by this		
10	provision. The Contracting Agency does not guarantee that fuel will be available at		
12	the base fuel cost or monthly fuel cost. No additional adjustment will be made for		
13	rates of fuel consumption or actual fuel types that differ from those specified for the		
14	purpose of determining the adjustment.

16	For the purpose of calculating the adjustment, the Base Fuel Cost shall be the		
17	<u>Weekly</u> fuel price from the U.S. Energy Information Administration website. The
