2 The areas where piles are to be driven are adjacent to highly developed areas.
3 It is essential that vibration and noise resulting from pile driving be held to a
4 minimum. Unless otherwise allowed by the Engineer, pile driving shall be
5 done during regular daytime working hours. The Contractor shall select pile
6 driving equipment which will minimize noise and vibration. When, in the
7 opinion of the Engineer, noise or vibration are excessive, the Contractor will be
8 required to use a hammer that does not exceed the minimum specifications by
9 more than 10 percent for the type and capacity of piling being driven. If pre-
10 boring, jetting, or other special methods are not specified elsewhere in the
11 contract and are ordered by the Engineer to reduce noise or vibration, such
12 change in method shall be considered a change, subject to the terms of
13 Section 1-04.4.
