2 ***Conservation Grade Plant Material***

3 Conservation grade plant material is defined as healthy plants that do not meet
4 aesthetic standards as defined in ASNS. The plants have healthy, well-developed roots
5 and in all other ways meet standards for healthy and vigorous growth. However, these
6 plants may have multiple leaders, damaged or missing leaders, Y crotches, bent
7 branches, or other unusual shapes or forms. These plants may be used where shown
8 in the plans.
