


Organized **CHAIN UP**

STREAMLINING TRUCK CHAIN-UP PROCEDURES ON SNOQUALMIE PASS

I-90 Snoqualmie Pass, milepost 55, westbound only

Tired of the chaos on I-90 when chaining up? WSDOT has a new process to reduce congestion and improve safety in the westbound direction of I-90, three miles east of Snoqualmie Pass.



FOLLOW THE SIGNS


When traction tires are required, trucks over 10,000 gross vehicle weight must chain up. Overhead signs will direct trucks to the chain-up area and notify trucks where a chain-up space is available.

CHAIN UP

Trucks will chain up in a single-file line. Trucks are discouraged from parking side-by-side and blocking other trucks. Leave space between your rig and the rig in front of you.

MERGE INTO TRAFFIC

Once chains are on, carefully merge back into traffic. Parking in the chain-up area is limited to 30 minutes to install chains and will be enforced. Parking and sleeping in the chain-up area is prohibited.
