

## What to expect if you're a subprime contractor

- Please fill out and print the attached form below.
- Be ready to connect with prime contractors and bring a statement of qualifications.
- Be ready to highlight the last three projects where you or your company made an important contribution.
- If your firm is eligible to register as a disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE), minority-owned business (MBE), women-owned (WBE), small or veteran-owned business, we need you to get certified. There will be assistance on-site to help businesses understand the process and next steps.
