

Updated Notice: Wall demolition work starts on Monday, April 21

Yesterday, you received a notice from us about the construction work to relocate the existing noise wall. We have additional information to share with you about the details and schedule of this work.

Starting on Monday, April 21, crews will begin demolition work to remove the existing noise wall. This work is necessary to access the tree removal area. Tree removal work will begin the week of April 28 with excavation activities scheduled to begin the week of May 5.

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and its contractor, Flatiron Constructors, are currently working to complete improvements on I-405 between NE 6th Street in Bellevue and I-5. Improvements include adding one new lane in each direction between NE 6th Street and SR 522, building wider shoulders, installing new stormwater infrastructure, and constructing or replacing eight noise walls to reduce freeway noise for nearby neighbors.



What should I expect during the demolition work?

Demolition work will take place during daytime hours, Monday through Friday. Crews will work to minimize noise and other disruptions during work hours. However, neighbors can expect to experience dust, hear noise and feel vibration during this work related to:

- The use of heavy machinery to demolish the existing noise wall
- Back up alarms on mobile equipment required for safety
- Construction crews and equipment entering and existing the work zone
