

Introduction to hot spot maps and Gantt charts:

Maps provide a broad look at anticipated impacts over an extended period of time within a given area. Not all activities shown will occur at the same time.

- The maps show approximate project locations and anticipated impacts shown by varying colors.
- Projects are labeled with numbers that correspond with the ID number on the Gantt charts.
- Arrows clarify direction of impacts. If arrows are not shown the impact occurs in both directions.
- Project(s) from other hot spots that have relevant impacts may be shown.
- Additional hot spot(s) may be shown on the map if they are close to this hot spot. Please refer to the maps and Gantt charts of the other hot spot(s) for detailed information on the projects and impacts within that area.

Gantt charts provide more detailed information on the anticipated impacts and schedules of construction and special events. (All information is subject to change)

- Basic project information is shown on the left including ID number (corresponds to number label on the map), contact information, start and end date, project title, etc.
- Detailed impact information is shown to the right. Special events and annual maintenance activities are listed at the bottom of the Gantt chart aligned with the month that they are expected to occur. Legends for the times of the shifts (AM Peak 6am-9am, Midday 9am-3pm, etc.) and impact colors (red – full closure, peach – partial closure, etc.) are provided at the bottom of the Gantt chart.
