

# 2015 Construction Season

## King County Area - Highlighted Projects



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## I-5: NE 117th to SR 104 – concrete panel replacement

- Complete replacement of 277 concrete panels, grind all lanes and restripe – project underway.
- Overnight lane and ramp closures
- Completion in summer 2015

## I-5: South 272nd Street to South Rose Street seismic retrofit

- Eight bridged sections of I-5 will be seismically retrofitted between South 272nd Street in Kent and South Rose Street in South Seattle – project underway.
- No closures of mainline I-5. Weeknight and weekday lane closures under overpasses.
- Complete in winter 2015

## SR 18: Green River (Neeley) Bridge – bridge painting

- Clean and repaint the eastbound Green River Bridge.
- Overnight lane closures and up to 20 full overnight closures
- Construction: spring to fall 2015

## I-90: Floating bridge anchor cable replacement

- Replaces anchor cables on the I-90 floating bridges
- Some overnight lane closures
- Construction: spring to fall 2015

## I-90: Two-way transit and HOV project

- Stage 3A: modify and reconstruct eastbound I-90 ramps to Bellevue Way and I-405
- Stage 3: Add HOV lanes between Mercer Island and Seattle; upgrade tunnel systems and lighting
- Construction: 2014 to mid-2017
- Overnight lane closures; weekend directional closures of outer or center roadway

## SR 99: Alaskan Way Viaduct replacement

- The project replaces the aging Alaskan Way Viaduct on Seattle's waterfront. Improvements include:
  - ▲ A two-mile-long tunnel beneath downtown Seattle.
  - ▲ A mile-long stretch of new highway that connects to the south entrance of the tunnel, near Seattle's stadiums.
  - ▲ A new overpass at the south end of downtown that allows traffic to bypass train blockages near Seattle's busiest port terminal.
- Construction: ongoing

## SR 99: West Fork Hylebos Creek fish passage culvert replacement

- Replaces 90 year old culvert under SR 99 with a new larger culvert and realigns the creek to make it more fish-friendly.
- One full weekend closure of SR 99 to dig up and replace the culvert; daytime single lane closures to realign the creek and restore area.
- Construction: summer to fall 2015

## SR 99: Aurora Bridge – bridge painting

- Paints portions of the Aurora Bridge, repairs and paints the pedestrian handrail.
- Daytime work under bridge with no lane closure; weekend single lane closures 9 a.m. – 9 p.m.; some nightly lane and ramp closures, closures of the Burke-Gilman trail
- Construction: spring 2015 to spring 2017

## SR 164: Hemlock St. to SE 408th – paving

- Repave 5.5 miles of SR 164 between Auburn and Enumclaw; upgrade eight pedestrian ramps to current ADA standards
- Shoulder closures for ADA work; overnight single lane closures with alternating traffic.
- Construction: summer to fall 2015

## SR 167: S. 272nd St. to Green River Bridge – paving

- Repave one mile of northbound SR 167
- Single or double nighttime lane closures
- Construction: summer 2015

## SR 167: 8th to 277th Southbound HOT lane – widen, extend HOT lanes

- Add a new lane in the southbound direction and extend the existing High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes
- One full weekend closure of SR 18 for widening of the SR 167 bridge over SR 18
- Nighttime lane closures
- Construction: spring 2015 to summer 2017

## SR 181: S. 180th Street to Southcenter Boulevard – paving and ADA

- Grind and repave 1.5 miles in Tukwila; upgrade seven pedestrian ramps to current ADA standards
- Daytime shoulder closures; overnight closures of multiple lanes
- Construction: summer to fall 2015

## SR 203: Coe-Clemons Creek CED

- Replace existing culvert with larger culvert to eliminate chronic environmental damage and improve fish passage
- Seven-day full closure of route; overnight lane closures
- Construction: July to September 2015

## I-405: Bellevue to Lynnwood Express Toll Lanes

- Complete construction of lanes and activate to express toll lane system
- Nightly lane closures
- Activation tentatively planned for fall 2015

## I-405: SE 8th to Northup Way – paving

- Complete permanent striping work
- Paving completed in summer 2014
- Overnight lane and ramp closures
- Construction: spring to fall 2015

## SR 509: S. Normandy Road to S. 174th paving

- Pave half mile stretch of SR 509 near Normandy Park; upgrade 13 pedestrian ramps to current ADA requirements.
- Night time single lane or directional lane closures.
- Construction: July to fall 2015

## SR 509: S. 160th to S. 112th paving

- Pave four mile stretch of southbound SR 509 near Burien; upgrade two pedestrian ramps to current ADA requirements.
- Full nighttime closure of southbound SR 509 required south of SR 518 interchange; night time lane closures.
- Construction: summer to fall 2015

## SR 518: WB 24th Ave. to I-5 interchange – paving

- Grind and repave westbound SR 518 between I-5 and 24th Ave.; resurface 8 ramps and partially resurface 3 ramps in the SR 518/I-5/I-405 interchange.
- Nighttime lane closures on SR 518, nighttime ramp and partial ramp closures
- Construction: spring 2015 to winter 2016

## SR 520: New floating bridge and West Approach Bridge North

- Construct new floating bridge and approach structures between Medina and Seattle; install temporary tolling infrastructure in Medina; construct one-mile-long temporary work bridge, demolish ramps, and construct local street improvements in the Montlake interchange area.
- Several weekend-long full highway closures, local roadway closures, nighttime single-lane and ramp closures.
- Construction: Ongoing – new floating bridge open to traffic in spring 2016; new West Approach Bridge North planned for completion in summer 2017.

## SR 900: Tukwila North City Limits to SR 167 interchange – paving, concrete replacement

- Replace more than 50 panels in both directions and repave 1,100 foot section at north end of project.
- Weekend closure, nighttime lane closures on SR 900; ramp closures on I-5 likely.
- Construction June to fall 2015
