


Pontoon W repairs and towing - Seattle

SR 520 construction update: September 2013

Eastside construction



During the SR 520 weekend closure on Sept 13-15, 2013, crews shifted westbound lanes to the south from 108th Avenue Northeast to Bellevue Way and to the north from Bellevue Way to Evergreen Point Road.

Floating bridge construction - Lake Washington




The existing SR 520 east approach and its columns are visible to the left. On the right, piers and bridge sections for the new east approach are under construction.

Crews have completed concrete pours on several columns for the new west connection bridge on Lake Washington, which will connect the new floating bridge to the existing SR 520 roadway.
