


East Montlake Water's Edge

What we heard

- Find a way to make the eastern Montlake lid portal and West Approach Bridge abutment fit more gracefully into the shoreline landscape.
- Create a shoreline experience that feels safe and looks pleasant.
- Create a safe north/south connection between East Montlake Park and the Arboretum to ensure that the shoreline shared-use path is well used.
- Integrate the stormwater facility more naturally into the park and shoreline setting.

East Montlake Water's Edge


Design opportunities

- Create a more open path with better sightlines by moving the eastern Montlake lid portal and West Approach Bridge abutment father away from the water's edge.
- Put activities under the bridge to create a "to" area along the shoreline.
- Create a better use of park space by putting the parking under the bridge.
- Make the stormwater facility fit more naturally in the shoreline setting by moving it closer to the water's edge.














View 2: Looking southeast near the East Montlake shoreline











What we heard

- Create a water feature (water park, stormwater garden) visually tied to waterfront.
- Make it park-like, paths, native plants, e.g. stormwater park at Madison Valley.
- No fences.
- Add interpretive signs to explain how the stormwater facility works.
- Prevent stagnation.

Design opportunities

- Create two smaller stormwater facilities and site them closer to the shoreline.
- Make the stormwater facility more park-like with a natural shape and native plants that tie into East Montlake Park.
