

PRO620-a: Initiate the Environmental Compliance Assurance Procedure

Effective September 2015

Start procedure: A staff member observes an [Environmental Compliance Assurance Procedure](#) (ECAP) Notification Trigger during construction.

End procedure: The Project Engineer and Region Environmental Manager work together on an appropriate response to the notification trigger to avoid or minimize environmental damage.

Actor:	Action:
Staff Member	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Observes an ECAP notification trigger.2. Immediately notifies the Project Engineer (or designee).
Project Engineer (or designee)	<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Implements the Notification and Resolution Process of ECAP (see SS 1-07.5 of the <i>WSDOT Construction Manual</i>).
Region Environmental Manager	<ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Receives notification from the Project Engineer.5. Implements Step 3 of the Notification and Resolution Process of ECAP (this includes working closely with the Project Engineer to reduce the issue that caused the notification trigger).
