



Children of the Sun Trail Access Point Locations

CHILDREN OF THE SUN TRAIL

The proposed North Spokane Corridor (NSC) includes a dedicated pedestrian/bicycle trail, that parallels the NSC, along the 10.5 mile route. The first half of the trail, extending from Francis Avenue to the Wandermere vicinity, opened in 2012, with various access points along the route. Future sections will connect neighborhoods with existing trails, including the Centennial and Ben Burr trails, and scenic viewpoints of the Spokane area. These will open as additional sections of the NSC are completed.

WSDOT sought public input for naming the trail, and after the names were submitted, a committee of local citizens and leaders reviewed the entries. Out of all the entries, "Children of the Sun" was chosen as the name of the trail. "Children of the Sun" is a phrase in the Salish language tied to the meaning of "Spokane".
