


Progress Path Project Cle Elum Roslyn Elementary, Walter Strom Middle School, and Cle Elum Roslyn High School

Grant Amount: \$294,000

February 2012



Performance Measures and Project Report Highlights:

- There was a 76% increase in the number of children walking and biking to school;
- There was a 100% reduction in the number of students walking and biking on the shoulder of SR903; and
- The new pathway has become a benefit to not only the Cle Elum – Roslyn School District but the entire Cle Elum community.

New Infrastructure:

- 4,900 feet of multi-use pathway
- Crosswalk improvements
- 300 feet of fencing

Project Description: This project provided a safe bicycle and pedestrian route between the two schools and the community of Cle Elum where there had been none before. It included a shared use path with fencing, crosswalk improvements, safety promotion activities, and police patrols.

Infrastructure Location: Adjacent to SR 903 between Ranger Station Road and the School campus.
