

# Daytime work on East Lake Washington Boulevard



Site preparation and construction activities include:

- Tree pruning and removal
- Pothole repair as needed
- Temporary removal of on-street parking for approximately six months


## Demolition of the former Museum of History and Industry (MOHAI) building

- Approximately four weeks
- Hours of demolition activities:
  - 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. on weekdays
  - 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. on weekends
- After the building is removed, the cleared area will be used for additional staging during construction

**Note:** All work is dependent on plans and schedule as determined by the contractor. Due to the dynamic nature of construction activities, schedules are subject to change.

# Local street and highway closures

## Single-lane closures

- Eastbound SR 520 on- and off-ramp to Montlake Boulevard
  - 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. through Feb. 5
- East Lake Washington Boulevard
  - 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. week of Feb. 2
- Montlake Boulevard East
  - Intermittent closures as early as 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning in February
  - Locations vary and dependent on work
  - Northbound bus stop closure

## Directional highway closure

- Westbound SR 520 from 92nd Avenue Northeast to Montlake Boulevard
  - 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Feb. 9 to 10


