Re: APE Concur; Not Eligible; Adverse Effect

Dear Mr. Holstine:

We have reviewed the materials forwarded to our office describing the changes to the Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the North Spokane Corridor Project, Phase II (I-90 to Spokane River) project. We concur with the revised definition of the APE, and your determination that the three additional historic properties encompassed by the new APE (2829 N. Ralph Street; 3218 E Fairview Ave; 3228 E Liberty Ave) are not eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

As previously determined, this undertaking will have an adverse effect on historic properties. We look forward to further consultation and the development of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to address adverse effects to the Prest-O-Lite Plant, N 4020 Market Street, and the Frank Atkinson House, 3221 E Grace, which were both previously determined eligible for listing on the NRHP, and which will now both be demolished.

These comments are based on the information available at the time of this review and on behalf of the State Historic Preservation Officer in conformance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and its implementing regulations 36CFR800. Should additional information become available, our assessment may be revised. We would appreciate receiving any correspondence or comments from concerned tribes or other parties that you receive as you consult under the requirements of 36CFR800.4(a)(4) and the survey report when it is available.
