Report to the Washington State Legislature**

Background

In 2005, the Governor and Washington State Legislature increased the state's role by providing funding that supports pedestrian and bicycle safety and safe routes to school projects (ESSB 6091). In addition, with the passage of SAFETEA-LU in 2005, a new federal Safe Routes to School program was established, that provided federal funding to the state.

The intent of the legislation focuses on pedestrian and bicycle safety and providing children a safe, healthy alternative to riding the bus or being driven to school. The state legislation requires WSDOT to identify cost-effective projects and submit a prioritized list to the legislature by December 15, 2008. To accomplish this, two separate calls for projects were offered that targeted these specific areas.

Previously Selected Projects

For Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety:

- \$15 million has been made available to 36 local agencies for 47 projects from the over \$63 million in requests.
- Four projects are completed and 43 underway.

For Safe Routes to Schools:

- \$10 million has been made available for 39 projects from the over \$46 million in requests.
- Improved walking and biking conditions for 58 schools in 30 school districts covering approximately 14,500 children (Source: OSPI).
- Six projects completed, 32 underway, and one cancelled.

For the 2005-07 grant cycle, the legislature approved funding in March 2006 and grant recipients were required to authorize the projects within one year. Similarly, for the 2007-09 grant cycle, the legislature approved funding in June 2007 and grant recipients were required to authorize the projects no later than June 1, 2008.

Timing for projects near schools and in urban settings is important. Many schools and school districts defer their projects until school is out and local agencies often prefer to work with area businesses to coordinate with other projects and minimize impacts.

2009-11 Call for Projects

For the 2009-2011 biennium, approximately \$11 million in state funding is available for the two programs and a total of \$82 million in requests have been received.

WSDOT issued a press release January 2008, announcing a “call for projects” for the two grant programs. Information on the grant programs was provided to all cities and counties and to the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction for distribution to schools and school districts throughout the state. To familiarize applicants with the grant programs, WSDOT provided multiple on-site reviews and gave presentations at statewide city and county conferences, Regional Transportation Planning Organization meetings, and spoke to other organizations including the Bicycle Alliance of Washington, Feet First, Washington Coalition for Promoting Physical Activity, County Road Administration Board, and Association of Washington Cities.

Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant proposals were due to the WSDOT by midnight on May 9, 2008. Safe Routes to School grant proposals were due to the WSDOT by midnight on May 2, 2008.

The department received 92 Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety projects from 65 agencies and organizations totaling approximately \$35 million and the department received 112 Safe Routes to Schools projects from 86 agencies and organizations totaling approximately \$47 million.

Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Grant Project Evaluation

The Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety program followed a similar process as the one used in the 2007-09 biennium. The purpose of this program is to aid public agencies in funding cost-effective projects that improve pedestrian and bicycle safety through engineering, education and enforcement. Eligibility criteria and an evaluation process were developed to ensure projects met the intent of the legislation.

Project proposals were evaluated and prioritized by a committee composed of one member from the, Washington Traffic Safety Commission and two members from the Washington State Department of Transportation. Projects providing a match were given preference. Before finalizing the project list, WSDOT made site visits to the project locations.

Safe Routes to School Grant Evaluation

The Safe Routes to School grant program followed a similar process as the one used in past biennia. The purpose of this program is to aid public agencies in funding cost-effective projects within two-miles of primary and middle schools (K-8) that provide children a safe, healthy alternative to riding the bus or being driven to school. The project proposals describing how the project will increase the number of students walking and biking to school by making improvements in areas of health and safety education, enforcement and engineering. Eligibility criteria and an evaluation process were developed to ensure projects met the intent of the legislation.

WSDOT utilized the existing Safe Routes to Schools Advisory Board to evaluate and prioritize the project proposals. The Safe Routes to Schools Advisory Board is comprised of nine members (one member each) from the Washington Traffic Safety Commission, Washington State Department of Health, Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, Mobility Education Foundation, Yakima Valley Conference of Governments, Skagit Valley Hospital, Bicycle Alliance of Washington, Feet First, and two members from the Washington State Department of Transportation.

Before finalizing the project list, WSDOT made site visits to the project locations.



2009-11 Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program Evaluation Criteria

All proposals were reviewed to ensure that they were complete and eligible for funding. An advisory group evaluated the proposals and made recommendations. WSDOT staff conducted site visits prior to developing the list of priorities.

The following criteria were used to evaluate the project proposals.

(1) Current Conditions – Do the current conditions indicate risk for pedestrians and/or bicyclists. Based on recent state and national research, arterial streets in urban areas with higher speeds and volumes, and housing mixed with commercial attractions, transit service, and other pedestrian and bicycle generators are the locations with the most collisions and risk.

5 Pts = High risk location. For example, a location with fatal or disabling pedestrian and/or bicyclist involved crash history on a high speed, high volume street/road in a population center.

3 Pts = Moderate risk location. For example, a location with pedestrian or bicyclist involved injury crash history on 30-40 mph, moderate volume road.

1 Pt = Lower risk location. For example, a location with demonstrated risk for pedestrians and bicyclists due to increasing development in the area, increasing traffic volumes, etc.

(2) Project Impact – How well will the project: reduce potential pedestrian and bicycle conflicts with motor vehicle traffic and/or establish safer and fully accessible crossings, walkways, trails or bikeways consistent with WSDOT Design Standards or the AASHTO “Guide for the Planning Design, and Operation of Pedestrian Facilities” or “Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities”.

5 Pts = Substantial long term solution.

3 Pts = Moderate improvements.

1 Pt = Little or no safety improvement to be derived from the project.

(3) Implementation – Is there a demonstrated need for the proposed improvements, and, if appropriate for the project/program, a strong partnership among local agencies that will ensure this project moves ahead on time and on budget.


5 Pts = Clear, committed multi-agency partnership and/or ability to complete the project between June 2009 and June 2011.

2009-11 Safe Routes to Schools Evaluation Criteria

All proposals were reviewed to ensure that they are complete and eligible for funding. The WSDOT Safe Routes to Schools Advisory Board (drawn from sponsoring agencies, local officials and advocacy groups) evaluated the proposals and made recommendations. Site visits were conducted by WSDOT staff prior to finalizing the list of priorities.

The following criteria was used to evaluate the project proposals. The ranking criteria are expressed numerically, with 5 being the highest and 1 being the lowest.

(1) Engineering Improvements – How well the project has or will: reduce potential pedestrian and bicycle conflicts with motor vehicle traffic; reduce traffic volume around schools; and/or establish safer and fully accessible crossings, walkways, trails or bikeways consistent with WSDOT Design Standards or the AASHTO “Guide for the Planning Design, and Operation of Pedestrian Facilities” or “Guide for the Development of Bicycle Facilities”

5 Pts = Substantial long term solution.

3 Pts = Moderate improvements.

1 Pt = Little or no improvement included in the project.

(2) Education and Encouragement Efforts – How well the project has or will teach about: bicycling, walking and/or driving safety skills, the health effects of walking and biking, the impact to the environment, the broad range of transportation choices and provide events and activities utilized to promote walking and biking to school safely.

5 Pts = Substantial long term education and encouragement solutions such as policy changes or the adoption of curriculum that will continue after the project is complete.

3 Pts = Education and/or encouragement efforts in the vicinity of the project post construction period only.

1 Pt = Little or no education or encouragement included in the project.

(3) Enforcement Component – How well the enforcement efforts of the project has or will address traffic safety and help to increase the number of children walking and biking to school safely?

5 Pts = Substantial long term enforcement solutions.

3 Pts = Enforcement efforts in the vicinity of the project post construction period only.

1 Pt = Little or no enforcement efforts included in the project.

(4) Implementation – Is there a demonstrated need for the proposed improvements and a strong partnership among local agencies that will ensure this project moves ahead on time and on budget?

5 Pts = Clear, committed multi-agency partnership with completion date between June 2009 and June 2011.

3 Pts = Multi-agency partnership with completion date between June 2011 and June 2012.

1 Pt = No established partnerships or partnerships to be established after receipt of grant with completion date after June 2012.
