


Open House

You are invited to attend a WSDOT-hosted open house to learn about future improvements to traffic flow on Interstate 5 through the Joint Base Lewis-McChord area.

No formal presentation is scheduled. Those interested in attending are welcome anytime during the three - hour open house.

Proposed changes include:

- Adding one HOV lane to each direction of I-5.
- Rebuilding the Thorne Lane and Berkeley Street interchanges.
- Relocating the Steilacoom-DuPont Road interchange.
- Building a Gravelly Lake Drive to Thorne Lane connecting road.

From northbound Interstate 5

- Take exit 125 for Bridgeport Way SW
- Turn left onto Bridgeport Way SW
- Turn right onto Lakewood Dr SW
- Turn right onto Steilacoom Blvd SW
- Turn right onto Hageness Dr SW
- Arrive at McGavick Conference Center, Building 23. Parking is directly ahead.



From southbound Interstate 5

- Take exit 127 for SR 512 West (South Tacoma Way)
- Turn right onto South Tacoma Way
- Turn left onto Steilacoom Blvd
- Turn left onto Hageness Dr SW
- Arrive at McGavick Conference Center, Building 23. Parking is directly ahead.



I-5 JBLM Vicinity Congestion Relief

The top map shows proposed changes to the I-5 interchanges at Berkeley Street and Thorne Lane, and the proposed connecting road between Gravelly Lake Drive and Thorne Lane. Roundabouts would replace signals at the ramp termini.

The map to the left shows the proposed changes to the I-5 interchange at Steilacoom-DuPont Road. Changes here would be more significant. The changes would include removing the existing interchange, building a new interchange further north, and relocating the JBLM DuPont Gate. Roundabouts would replace signals at these ramp termini as well.
