Columbia River Crossing Task Force to Meet January 4

VANCOUVER – The Columbia River Crossing Task Force will meet on Wednesday, January 4. The Task Force, co-chaired by Dr. Hal Dengerink and Henry Hewitt, will discuss criteria to help measure the effectiveness of proposed project alternatives. Project staff will provide an update briefing on the history and scope of the Columbia River Crossing project.

The Task Force will consider a variety of issues including congestion, freight movement, high capacity transit, environmental issues, and funding concerning a new or improved river crossing between Portland and Vancouver. The Task Force will meet frequently over the next two to three years, through the duration of the project's environmental process.
