



### Governor tours new Mukilteo terminal site

Gov. Jay Inslee toured the area of our new [Mukilteo Multimodal Terminal Project](#) last week. WSF staff, contractor crews and I showed him around the construction site, including the recently completed shell of the new passenger building and current work on the berthing structures. When the terminal opens in fall, it will provide a larger vehicle holding area and overhead loading for walk-on passengers, along with features paying respect to the tribal history of the location, which is the site of the 1855 Treaty of Point Elliott.

#### Thousands of bicyclists on our Seattle/Bainbridge route Sunday, Feb. 23

If you're using our Seattle/Bainbridge route Sunday, Feb. 23, plan for delays and limited vehicle capacity as more than 2,000 bicyclists head to the island for the annual [Chilly Hilly](#) ride. Expect a lot of bikes on the 7:55, 8:55 and 9:35 a.m. sailings out of Seattle, then on all Bainbridge departures between the 11:35 a.m. and 3 p.m. sailings. Drivers should consider alternate travel times or routes. Participants are asked to follow directions from our staff and Cascade Bicycle Club volunteers at the terminals and on our vessels.
