To ensure both current and historical interchange system information is available to all who utilize the Interchange Drawing Viewer, some of the Interchange Drawing PDF files will display with hand-sketched updates. New hand-sketched files will be added when updated information is received through construction and maintenance channels. New CAD drawings will be added as they are completed. There is currently a five-year backlog on updating the CAD drawings.

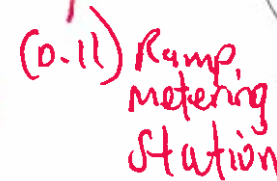
