THIS MATTER having come on for hearing pursuant to the Order to Show Cause dated January 27, 2013, the Court having considered Plaintiff's Motion for Order to Show Cause and Memorandum in Support thereof, (the "Motion"), the supporting Declarations of Tracy Vedder and Judith Endejan, and Complaint for Violation of the Public Records Act, and the State's Memorandum in Opposition + Supporting Declarations, and having considered the presentation of counsel and deeming at a hearing held on 2/7/13; itself otherwise fully advised, the Court hereby

ORDERS as follows:

1. The Defendant shall disclose to Plaintiff ~~within 24 hours of the date of this Order~~ within 24 hours of the date of this Order unredacted copies of the Weekly Reports provided to Tracy Vedder on January 7, 2013.
2. Operation of this Order is stayed until Feb. 21, 2013, so the State may seek appeal, if desired.
