### I-405/NE 132nd Street Interchange Project

### **Project overview**

- Provides access improvements by building new half-diamond interchange
- Replaces signals with roundabouts and adds pedestrian and bike infrastructure
- Corrects fish barrier creating over 3,000 feet of upstream habitat gain

## I-405/Brickyard to SR 527 Express Toll Lanes Improvement Project

### **Project overview**

- Extends dual ETLs from SR 522 to SR 527
- Builds direct access ramps with inline stations at SR 522 and SR 527 interchanges
- Connections to urban growth centers and transit nodes
- Provides trail, pedestrian, and bike improvements
- Addresses system preservation and resiliency
- Corrects 6 fish barriers



# Stride Bus Rapid Transit Opens 2026-2027

S1 Line: Bellevue to BurienS2 Line: Bellevue to LynnwoodS3 Line: Shoreline to Bothell

- Connects to Link light rail in Shoreline, Lynnwood, Bellevue and Tukwila
- Limited-stop service in the I-405, SR 522 and SR 518 corridors




# Stride Program Elements

## BRT: Fast, frequent, reliable service

*I-405 BRT infrastructure designed for fast, frequent and reliable service* 

- 10-minute peak,15-minute off-peak headways for I-405 BRT
- Up to 19 hours of service Monday through Saturday
- Up to 17 hours on Sunday





# **Stride Fleet and Stations**

- State of the art passenger information
- Offboard fare payment, except for cash
- Bicycle accommodations: front racks on the bus & storage at select stations
- Currently evaluating double-decker propulsion options

  - Board direction on program budget and schedule approval expected in early 2023





## Stride BRT to travel exclusively in Express Toll Lanes for a majority of the corridor

#### AM peak hour travel times to Bellevue






### SR 167 Puyallup to Renton Heatmaps – Peak Period (Average Weekdays)










## **Total Annual Project Funds Requested**



Fiscal year end 6/30. Dollar in millions.




## **Projected Net Toll Revenues**




# What's next?
